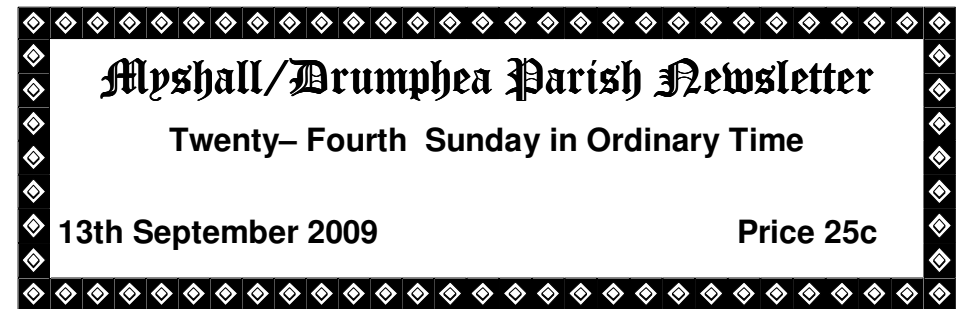

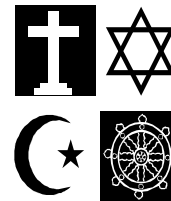

Are you childminding or thinking of setting up as a childminder in your own home?

FETAC Level 5 – Childminding Practice Module is due to commence Autumn 2009 at the Carlow Institute of Further Education in conjunction with Carlow County Childcare Committee. This Accredited Training Module is designed to equip the potential/current childminder with the skills and knowledge to care for children in a home setting. The module aims to promote good practice in early years care.

Childminders Start Up Programme is due to take place on Saturday 3rd and 10th October 2009 in St. Catherine's Community Services Centre, Carlow. This two day programme is designed to assist current and potential childminders to set up and run a childminding service in their own home.
