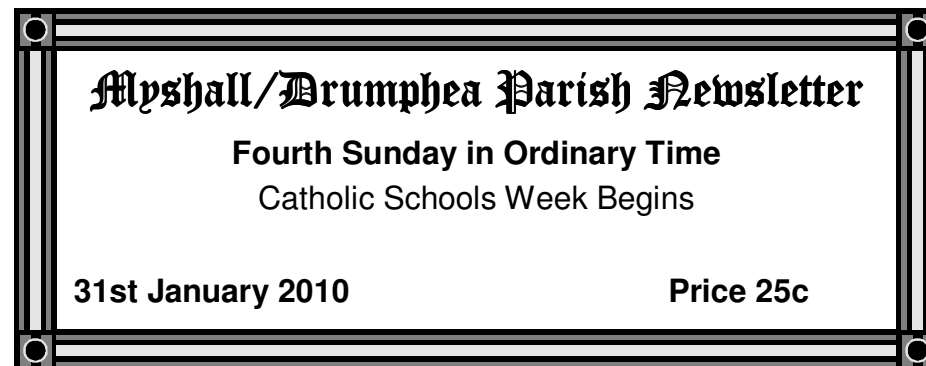
Fundraiser for Haiti

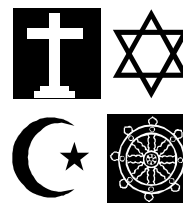
