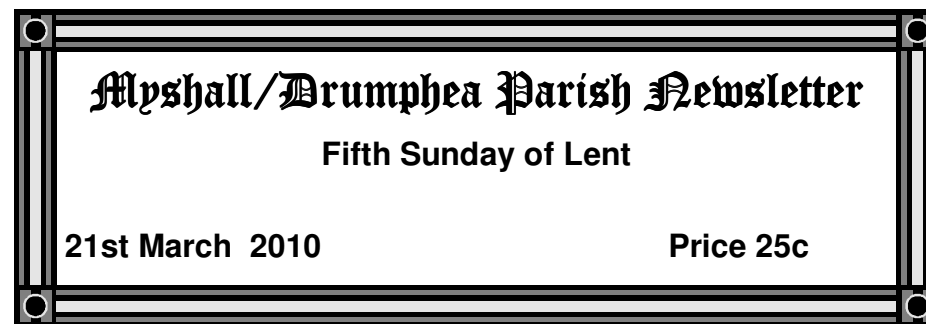
MYSHALL MUINTIR NA TÍRE

337 replies were handed in. (Over 90% of Mass goers)

61 were inconclusive in that both options were marked or only suggestions to retain 3 masses.

128 were for the option of Mass in Myshall on Saturday evening and Drumpea on Sunday.

148 were for the other option.
