## MYSHALL COMMUNITY CENTRE

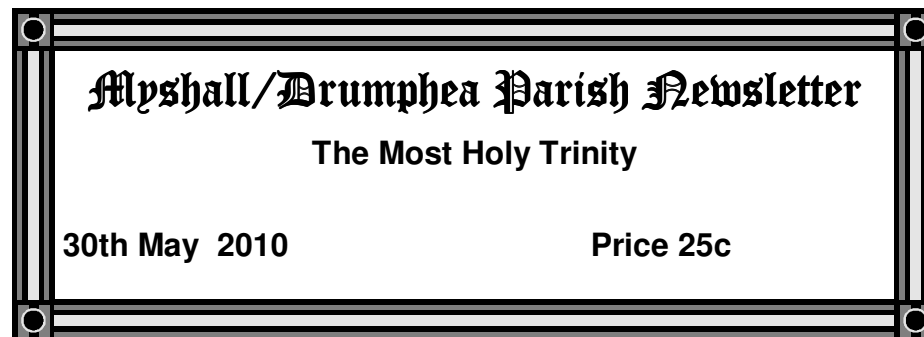
