Congratulations to Naomh Eoin under 21 footballers who are in the U-21 'A' Championship final after defeating Clonmore and a fancied Rathvilly last week, they will now meet Michael Davitts in the final, for a unique first time. 1968 and 1973, the last time they were in the A final.
